

HOW TO ORDER REPAIR PARTS

Each Advantage Rollers has its own model and serial number.

The model and serial number for the Advantage Rollers is located on the front of the frame see Figure 3.

Always mention the model and serial number when calling for service or when ordering repair parts.

All parts listed and illustrated in this manual may be ordered through your nearest authorized dealer. If parts you need are not available locally, your order will be processed through the factory and shipped promptly.

When ordering repair parts, have the following information ready:

- 1. Item part number
- 2. Quantity needed
- 3. Part description
- 4. Advantage Rollers model and serial number

Be sure to record both the model and serial number of your Advantage Rollers upon delivery. Keep this information in a safe place for future reference.

LIMITED WARRANTY STATEMENT

3-year Limited Warranty

TurfTime Equipment, LLC, (TTE) hereby warrants that TTE's products will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use according to the provisions and limitations herein set forth. All parts, specifically EXCLUDING expendable 'wear' parts, that become unserviceable, due to defective material or workmanship, within 3 YEARS of date of the original retail purchase, shall, at TTE's option, be repaired or replaced as detailed below.

If the equipment is used for rental purposes, warranty is limited to 90 days from the initial rental date.

Limitations

SETUP AND OPERATION

SAFETY

While operating this equipment use common sense and follow all safety guidelines.

In addition to observing the specific precautions listed throughout this manual, the following general statements apply. These must be adhered to in order to insure proper and safe operation.

A DANGER

Keep hands and feet from under the equipment at all times. Make sure that all people are safely clear of the equipment before operating.

In order to prevent serious injury and to promote safe operation, keep shields in place during operation, and insure that all mounting hardware is properly tightened.

WARNING

DO NOT attempt to operate the equipment in areas with steep inclines, ditches, large rocks, stumps, or holes that may upset the tractor, endangering the operator or damaging the equipment.

Never clean, adjust or repair the equipment while it or the tractor are running. Never attempt to pull material from any part of the equipment while it is running.

Ensure that the tractor is capable of handling the attached equipment. Consult the owner's manual of your specific tractor for the towing capacity or 3-point hitch lift capacity. Never exceed these limits.

Never wear loose clothing while operating the equipment as it may become caught in the moving parts of the machine.

Never allow anyone to ride on the equipment or tow vehicle.

For safe operation of the equipment, periodically inspect all parts for excessive wear. Replace worn components with authorized parts.

To prevent the hitch from becoming disconnected during operation, always use the proper size hitch pin and safety cotter.

Be sure to use proper safety chains when towing equipment on a public roadway.

A CAUTION

Most equipment accidents can be avoided by the observance of a few simple safety precautions.

Do not clean, lubricate or make any adjustments on the equipment while it is in motion.

Do not start the machine until you know everyone is clear of the area and all tools have been stowed away.

Do not work around the unit in loose clothing that might catch on any of the moving parts.

Do not attempt to pull material from any part of the equipment while it is in operation.

Replace all shields after lubrication or repairs.

Do not allow anyone to ride on the equipment

Park on level ground or block wheels to prevent the machine from rolling

Always follow manufacturer's instructions for maintenance, repair and adjustments

Read and pay close attention to hydraulic line safety.

SETUP AND ADJUSTMENT

NOTE: Not following these instructions may void the warranty

Attaching Pull-type Roller to the Tractor

Always attach the roller to the tractor on a firm, level surface.

Pull-Type Rollers

- Adjust the roller tongue jack so the height of the tongue matches the height of the tractor drawbar.
- 2. Back the tractor up to the roller, sliding the drawbar into the hitch until the pin holes line up.
- 3. Turn off the tractor engine and apply the parking brake.
- 4. Insert a 1-inch diameter hitch pin through the roller tongue and drawbar. Secure it with a cotter pin.
- 5. If the roller is equipped with a wheel cylinder kit, attach the hydraulic hoses to the tractor.
- 6. Lower the jack so the weight rests on the drawbar, pull the pin and rotate it into storage position.

Adding Fluid to the Roller

The roller should be filled with fluid to increase the weight and affect on the ground surface. To fill the roller:

A CAUTION

A partially-filled roller will allow the fluid to slosh around more than a fully-loaded roller. This will be more noticeable with a 3-point hitch, but in any arrangement, could cause instability of a tractor that is too light.

- 1. Position the roller so one of the 2-inch plugs is positioned at the top.
- 2. Remove the top plug and fill with water to the desired weight.




Figure 1. Roller Fill/Vent and Drain Plugs

NOTICE

Water weighs 8.34 lb. (3.78 kg) per gallon at 62°F. Other fluids may be used, such as ethylene glycol antifreeze, but be aware that they may kill grass if a spill occurs while filling.

 When filled to the desired level, reinstall the plug securely. Apply a small amount of grease or anti-seize to the plug threads to minimize oxidation.

OPERATION

Transport

When transporting the roller, fully raise the roller to avoid contact with roads, banks, etc.

For standard rollers without the hydraulic wheel kit, transport the roller at a reduced speed when on paved or stone roads. Be aware of the loaded weight of the roller when traveling, avoiding objects that may be crushed.

General use

The Advantage roller will be most efficient when the full weight of the machine is applied to the ground.

Initial

After initial inspection following delivery of your roller, check for any loose parts. Verify that the roller turns freely on the axle.

Seasonal Each Spring and Fall

Lubricate the grease fittings on each end of the roller. Never over-grease as this will push the seals out of the bearings, causing bearing failure.

Ensure that all bolts and nuts are tightened properly.

Winter

The water must be removed from the roller before subjected the roller to below freezing temperatures. Failure to do so could result in damage to the roller.

NOTICE

If a solution other than water has been used, it must be disposed of properly.

- 1. Position the roller so the 2-inch drain plug is in the lowest position.
- 2. Remove the drain plug and allow the water to drain. Removing the upper drain plug will allow the water to flow faster.
- 3. When the roller is empty, replace the drain plugs. Place a small amount of grease or antiseize on the plug threads to prevent oxidation and rust.

NOTICE

If the plugs are not reinstalled and the inside of the roller sealed, rust may form, eventually causing damage.

MAINTENANCE

LUBRICATION

The Advantage Roller requires a minimum amount of lubrication. However, the importance of sufficient and proper lubrication cannot be overstated as it is the best insurance against unnecessary repairs and will greatly increase the life of the machine.

Recommended procedure

Use a high-quality, extreme pressure (EP) 2 lithium grease on all bearings. Examples of acceptable grease are ExxonMobil Ronex MP and Libriplate 1200-2.

Ensure grease fittings are free of pain and dirt. Grease should be forced into the fittings until it comes out around the shaft.

NOTICE

Do not over-lubricate sealed bearings. Apply onehalf stroke or pump from a grease gun once per year.

Lubricate all roller bearings once per year.





Figure 2. Roller bearings
