

#### **3-year Limited Warranty**

TurfTime Equipment, LLC, (TTE) hereby warrants that TTE's products will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use according to the provisions and limitations herein set forth. All parts, specifically EXCLUDING expendable 'wear' parts, that become unserviceable, due to defective material or workmanship, within 3 YEARS of date of the original retail purchase, shall, at TTE's option, be repaired or replaced as detailed below.

If the equipment is used for rental purposes, warranty is limited to 90 days from the initial rental date.

#### Limitations

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#### **SAFETY**

While operating this equipment use common sense and follow all safety guidelines.

In addition to observing the specific precautions listed throughout this manual, the following general statements apply. These must be adhered to in order to insure proper and safe operation.

### DANGER

Keep hands and feet from under the equipment at all times. Make sure that all people are safely clear of the equipment before operating.

In order to prevent serious injury and to promote safe operation, keep shields in place during operation, and insure that all mounting hardware is properly tightened.

## **AWARNING**

DO NOT attempt to operate the equipment in areas with steep inclines, ditches, large rocks, stumps, or holes that may upset the tractor, endangering the operator or damaging the equipment.

Never clean, adjust or repair the equipment while it or the tractor are running. Never attempt to pull material from any part of the equipment while it is running.

Never wear loose clothing while operating the equipment as it may become caught in the moving parts of the machine.

For safe operation of the equipment, periodically inspect all parts for excessive wear. Replace worn components with authorized parts.

Always raise the Advantage Aerator when turning the machine. Failure to do so may damage the tines and roller bearings.

To prevent the hitch from becoming disconnected during operation, always use the proper size hitch pin and safety cotter pin.

Be sure to use proper safety chains when towing equipment on a public roadway.

## **A** CAUTION

Most equipment accidents can be avoided by the observance of a few simple safety precautions. Do not clean, lubricate or make any adjustments on the equipment while it is in motion.

Never allow the tank to freeze in the Advantage Aerators as severe equipment damage may result.

Do not start the machine until you know everyone is clear of the area and all tools have been stowed away.

Do not work around the unit in loose clothing that might catch on any of the moving parts.

Do not attempt to pull material from any part of the equipment while it is in operation.

Replace all shields after lubrication or repairs.

Do not allow anyone to ride on the equipment.

Park on level ground or block wheels to prevent the machine from rolling.

Always follow manufacturer's instructions for maintenance, repair and adjustments.

Read and pay close attention to hydraulic line safety.

## **WARNING**

Never attempt to stop a leak by covering it with your hand as doing so can cause severe injury.

TurfTime Equipment LLC assumes no liability for injuries sustained because of failure to read this manual or due to carelessness. Always refer to this manual for guidance, or contact your local dealer.

#### **ASSEMBLY**

#### **Inspection**

While Advantage Aerators are shipped fully assembled, it is recommended that an inspection be made upon receipt and any damage or shortages be reported to the shipping company.

#### **Warranty**

Locate the warranty card in the literature packet and complete it. For proper warranty registration TurfTime requires that you fill out the warranty registration card and return it within 30 days.

#### **Setup**

The Advantage Aerator can be operated as a 3-point mount or pull-type configuration. In addition, gauge wheels, required for pull-type configurations and optional on 3-point mount configurations, may need to be installed.

#### **3-Point Connection**

Depending on the size of the Advantage Aerator, the 3-point hitch will be either Cat. 1 or 2. See specifications table for details.

To mount the aerator to the 3-point hitch of a tractor.

- 1. Position the tractor in front of the aerator.
- 2. Use the appropriate holes for the upper and lower attachment points on the aerator.
- Install the proper size pins in the correct positions.




Figure 1-1. 3-point hitch connections

4. Secure all mounting pins with clevis pins.

#### Drawbar

The drawbar attaches to the 3-point hitch mounting points with the same mounting pins. An adjustable top link supports the drawbar.




Figure 1-2. Drawbar attachment

Adjust the top link so the drawbar is level when the tines are resting on the ground.

#### **Gauge Wheels**

The gauge wheels attach to the rear frame of the aerator. The gauge wheel position is controlled via a hydraulic cylinder.




Figure 1-3. Gauge wheel attachment

When routing the hydraulic hoses from the cylinder to the tractor, ensure the hoses are securely positioned in the clamps.

#### Smooth roller

The optional smooth roller attaches under the Adantage Aerator frame behind the rotor. It can be easily removed, if an operation does not require it, by removing two pins on each side.

Position the roller assembly under the frame and secure it in place with the pivot pin on each side.




Figure 1-4. Roller adjustment

A second pin on each side sets the pressure supplied to the ground by the roller by adjusting the distance from the frame.

#### Before use

Before initial use, check the following:

Check for proper assembly and adjustment making sure all bolts are securely tightened. Re-tighten the bolts after 4 hours of operation.

Torque the wheel bolts to 120 lb-ft.

Check the tires and inflate them to the recommended pressure shown on the side wall of each tire.

Adjust the tractor hitch and attach the Advantage Aerators to the tractor as detailed in this manual.

Connect the hydraulic hoses to the tractor hydraulic ports, if required.

Lubricate the machine completely and check the oil level in the hydraulic reservoir, if applicable.

Do not operate the Advantage Aerators until after "Safety" on page 1 in this manual has been read and understood by the operator.

Review ""Figure 3-6. Decals" on page 19 and ensure that all the decals are legible on the Advantage Aerator. Read and understood each decal and understand what the dangers involved.

#### **Drawbar connection**

## WARNING

Use only a 7/8" hitch pin of sufficient length to engage the upper and lower clevis of the drawbar.

Always use a clip to secure the hitch pin in the drawbar.

#### **OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS**

#### **NOTICE**

Not following these instructions may void the warranty.

#### **Hydraulic requirements**

If using the tow vehicle hydraulics, it must provide a minimum of 4 gpm flow at 1750 psi. Adjustable oil flow is recommended to limit the oil flow to less than 8 gpm. Oil flow outside of this range may result in hydraulic components overheating and insufficient operational quality.

#### **NOTICE**

Refer to the tow vehicle documentation for details on setting and maintaining the hydraulic flow and pressure recommendations.

## **WARNING**

Hydraulic oil under pressure can penetrate the skin causing serious personal injury. Before applying pressure to the system, ensure that all lines and couplers are tight and not damaged.

Before disconnecting lines, be sure to relieve pressure in the system.

Always clean the hydraulic quick couplers on the tow vehicle and Advantage Aerator before connecting.

#### **OPERATION**

#### Weight

### **CAUTION**

Never allow the tank to freeze in the Advantage Aerators as severe equipment damage may result.

Water tanks are installed on the frame to provide weight for the application. The additional weight provided by adding water is 8.3 lb. per gallon.

A full, 65-gallon tank provides about 540 additional pounds to the aerator.

### Operating speed

While the ideal operating speed of the unit depends on the soil conditions and capability of the tractor, operating speeds can range from 3 to 8 mph.

### Parking stands

A parking stand is located in each corner of the Advantage Aerator. When using the Advantage Aerator, all four stands must be up completely and secured in place with the provided hitch and cotter pins.

Before disconnecting from the tractor, remove the cotter and hitch pins to lower all four parking stands. Insert the hitch pins in the top holes and secure the parking stands.

### **MAINTENANCE**

## **AWARNING**

Always stop the machine and turn off the power supply before servicing the machine.

#### LUBRICATION

The Advantage Aerators requires a minimum amount of lubrication. However, the importance of sufficient and proper lubrication cannot be overstated as it is the best insurance against unnecessary repairs and will greatly increase the life of the machine.

#### Recommended procedure

Use a high-quality, extreme pressure (EP) 2 lithium grease on all bearings. Examples of acceptable grease are Exxon Mobil Ronex MP and Lubriplate 1200-2.

Ensure grease fittings are free of pain and dirt. Grease should be forced into the fittings until it comes out around the shaft.

#### **NOTICE**

Do not over-lubricate sealed bearings. Apply one-half stroke or pump from a grease gun once per year.

Lubricate all roller bearings once per year.

Lubricate all belt-tightening bearings once per year.




Figure 2-1. Wheel Hub Lubrication

#### **GENERAL**

## **A** CAUTION

Always replace shields after maintenance and before beginning operation.

Protect the machine from weather when it is not in use.

At the end of each season, check the Advantage Aerators carefully and replace all worn or damaged parts. Use only genuine TurfTime parts supplied by your authorized TurfTime dealer.

#### Wheels and tires

Once each month:

Check the lug bolt torque on each wheel. Bolts should be torqued to 120 lb-ft.

Check tires for cuts and damage.

Ensure tires are properly inflated.

#### **Hydraulic system**

Once per month:

Inspect the hydraulic hoses for flexibility and any sign of rubbing or cracking. Replace any hose where a defect is found.

Ensure the tow vehicle hydraulics are well maintained with clean oil. Follow the prescribed maintenance plan of the tow vehicle.

#### Wheel bearings

Wheel hub bearings must be adjusted after 100 loads or one year, whichever comes first.

To adjust the wheel hub torque:

- 1. Park the Advantage Aerators on a level place and chock the wheels to ensure that it will not roll or move.
- 2. Raise one side of the Advantage Aerators using a jack or appropriate lifting device.




Figure 2-2. Wheel Hub

- 3. Remove the hub cap from the center of the hub.
- 4. Remove the cotter pin from the slotted nut and loosen the slotted nut (rotate it counterclockwise) a turn or two.

## **MAINTENANCE**

- 5. While rotating the hub, use a torque wrench to torque the slotted nut to 35 lb-ft.
- Rotate the slotted nut counterclockwise (back-off) just enough for a nut slot to align with the axle hole. Install the cotter pin through the slotted nut and axle. Do not back-off the slotted nut more than one-third turn.
- 7. Repeat steps 2 through 6 for the other side of the machine.

### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible cause	Check
Hydraulic system doesn't have sufficient power to operate	Obstruction in hydraulic lines	See hydraulic maintenance section
	Oil overheated	Review hydraulic system requirements and ensure vehicle satisfies requirements
	Hydraulic oil level too low	Fill oil reservoir (vehicle or auxiliary engine hydraulic reservoir) to proper level

- 3. Part description

Be sure to record both the model and serial number of your Advantage Aerators upon delivery. Keep this information in a safe place for future reference.




Figure 3-1. Frame and Related Parts




Figure 3-2. Rotor, Tines and Related Parts




Figure 3-3. Optional Wheel Kit, Drawbar and Related Parts




Figure 3-4. Hydraulics Optional Wheel Kit and Related Parts




Figure 3-5. Optional Roller and Related Parts
